There is to be an Ordinary Meeting of the above Council, on Wednesday, 14th December 2022 starting at 6.00pm, being held at the St Mary's Community Centre

You are hereby summoned to attend. The agenda is as follows:

- To note those present, to receive and consider for approval, apologies for absence and reasons given. Schedule 12 of the Local Government Act 1972 requires a record to be kept of the members present and that this record form part of the minutes of the meeting. Members who cannot attend a meeting should tender apologies to the Clerk as it is usual for the grounds upon which apologies are tendered also to be recorded. Under Section 85(1) of the Local Government Act1972, members present must decide whether the reason(s) for a member's absence are accepted.
- To declare any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPIs), Other Significant Interests (OSIs) or Voluntary Interests (VIs) relating to items on the agenda. A member who declares a DPI in relation to any item on the agenda will need to leave the meeting for the whole of that item and will not be able to speak or take part unless a relevant Dispensation has been granted. A member who declares an OSI will be able to speak on the item but will be required to leave the meeting for the vote. Councillors may also declare a voluntary Interest if they are unsure of their position. Inclusion and voting will be decided at the time or the declaration.

- Public Open Session for members of the public who may make representations, give evidence, ask and answer questions regarding items on the agenda or to suggest issues for discussion at a future meeting. This item will include reports from Neighbourhood Watch and the PCSO (This item will last no more than 15 minutes)

Candidates will be given five minutes maximum to introduce themselves to Councillors, give information on their background and experience and explain why they wish to become a Councillor. Councillors may request points of clarification on the information provided by the candidate, through the Chair. The process will be carried out by adjourning the meeting to allow the candidate to speak. The Council may resolve that it does not require any candidate to speak, and proceed to a debate and vote on the applications.
