The agenda is as follows:**

- 25/24F To note those present, to receive and consider for approval, apologies for absence and reasons given.** *Schedule 12 of the Local Government Act 1972 requires a record to be kept of the members present and that this record form part of the minutes of the meeting. Members who cannot attend a meeting should tender apologies to the Parish Clerk as it is usual for the grounds upon which apologies are tendered also to be recorded. Under Section 85(1) of the Local Government Act 1972, members present must decide whether the reason(s) for a member's absence are accepted.*
- 26/24F To declare any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPIs), Other Significant Interests (OSIs) or Voluntary Interests (VIs) relating to items on the agenda.** *A member who declares a DPI in relation to any item on the agenda will need to leave the meeting for the whole of that item and will not be able to speak or take part unless a relevant Dispensation has been granted. A member who declares an OSI will be able to speak on the item but will be required to leave the meeting for the vote. Councillors may also declare a voluntary Interest if they are unsure of their position. Inclusion and voting will be decided at the time or the declaration.*
- 27/24F To elect** a Committee member to the vacant position of Chair for this committee until 2025 Annual Council Meeting
- 28/24F To consider to elect** a Committee member to the position of Vice Chair for this committee until 2025 Annual Council Meeting.
- 29/24F To agree** a Committee member to the Communication and Events Working Group until 2025 Annual Council Meeting.
- 30/24F To consider and adopt** Minutes of the Environment and Open Spaces Committee Meeting.
- 31/24F Public Open Session** *for members of the public who may make representations, ask and answer questions and give evidence regarding items on the agenda or to suggest issues for discussion at a future meeting. (This item will last no more than 15 minutes).*
- 32/24F 20-is-Plenty:** Committee to **consider** results of survey for Ulley Road, Nettlefield and surrounding roads and make recommendations to Council
- 33/24F Bockhanger and Bybrook Community Facility:** Committee to **receive** an oral update and **consider** next steps to engage architects to produce outline schemes
