Resolved: Agreed that the we need to works towards being ready to apply for a grant should a suitable one or multiple become available.

Action: Agreed the Clerk to find out the plans, size and cost of the Victoria Park community development. Additionally how operates and is managed and covers operating and staff costs.

- 4) Speed Indicator consider first location to consider along Faversham Road a little along from the raised section row of houses and layby.

52/23F War Memorial Restoration: Committee to consider paper sent to Council 11th October an and agree any next step/actions.

Noted: Agreed that the next steps to be considered reference tarmac surrounding and verges close by, new railings and a suitable vessel for the crosses that are left to be put in at a future meeting.

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53/23F Daffodil Bulb Planting: Committee to receive an oral update on current progress and agree any next step/actions.

Noted: The school have again shown an interest however this is often subject to weather constraints and therefore hopeful that this can happen this year and not rained of each time as previously.

Noted: To consider an alternative bull to be planted to compliment the daffodils as well as in filling by growing daffodils in other location such as in growing bags at the allotments and transferred once flowers have shown through.

Action: Agreed Clerk to work with Freedom Leisure and ABC and bring costings to Council as soon as possible.
